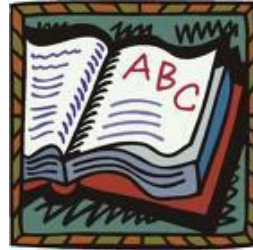

### English

Reading comprehension skills will be a big focus to ensure that children fully understand what they have read and can discuss this confidently.

### Mathematics

Children will be focusing on place value including, addition and subtractions, counting in 5s, multiplication and division, fractions and problems solving and reasoning.
