

## All Saints National Academy Primary School

### Primary PE and Sport Premium 2018 - 2019 Report

The below table displays the Primary PE and Sport Premium spend for All Saints National Academy during the 2017 - 2018 academic year. At the start of the academic year the Senior Leadership Team and PE Leaders within the school created an action plan to improve the quality of PE and school sport in a sustainable way, using the funding.

The total amount of funding given to the school during the 2018-2019 academic year was £16000 plus £10 per pupil (total: £19150). The government have given all schools the following areas to consider:

- the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
- the profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport
