


## PE

## Labelling clothes and belongings


Please ensure that all clothes, bags and lunchboxes are clearly labelled with your child's name. It is your child's responsibility to care for their own belongings.

### English

Topics will include:

*Story writing - thinking about where a magic key may take us.*

*We are also using the book 'Emperors Egg'. The children will write instructions, a leaflet about an egg and go on an imaginary journey.*


*The children will be using a lot of drama to help make the stories come alive.*
